EUSTORY History Competition in the Czech Republic

Competition Report of the 12th Round 2020/2021

The topic of the twelfth competition round of EUSTORY in the Czech Republic was “The Impact of World History on Personal History in the 20th Century“. The Czech competition was launched in 2000. Since 2013 the competition is organised, coordinated and conducted by the civic initiative “PANT“.

This year’s competition round ended on 22nd October 2021 with an award ceremony at “Centrum PANT“ in Ostrava. 39 students took part in the competition and they submitted 35 works altogether. The best submissions were awarded, the winners received iPhones, financial prizes, books, and magazine subscriptions for the Czech magazines “Dějiny a současnost“ (*Present and Past*) and “Paměť a dějiny“ (*Commemoration and History*).
